We offer a two-year warranty on our G4 Ultra Bridges. In the rare case of dental implant failure, not only will we remove the dental implant and replace it at no charge, but any corrective procedures required will also be performed at no cost.

Dental Implant Warranty Limitations: If a dental implant fails to integrate we will replace it at no cost, one time only. An annual dental implant examination including x-rays and regular cleanings is an absolute requirement for any warranty to apply. The Warranty does not apply to continue to patients who continue to smoke or persons who have or who develop, an uncontrolled systemic health problem, such as, but not limited to; diabetes, autoimmune disorders, severe osteoporosis, or any condition requiring long steroid use. If smoking or a medical condition is suspected as the cause of implant failure or other complication that requires treatment, an examination and blood tests will be required for warranties to apply.
